This project, which stems from the findings of an earlier project, sought to (a) identify the factors which limit the use of the Bankhead National Forest/Sipsey Wilderness Area (BNF/SWA) in North Alabama by minorities, (b) investigate the behavior, use patterns, and participation levels in various recreational activities by visitors to the BNF/SWA, and (c) recruit, mentor, and train a few HBCU students (undergraduate and graduate) in the science of outdoor recreation research.
