

Testing Updates: August 14, 2020

Dear Students,

As an update regarding GuideSafe Entry Testing, we have submitted information to the testing agency for all students registered as of Wednesday, August 12, 2020. For students needing to test, testing instructions will be sent to your University email account again today, Friday, August 14, 2020. Please promptly create your account with GuideSafe using your Alabama A&M University email account to schedule testing, if needed. Please call the GuideSafe Help Center at 1-866-839-5308 if you are experiencing problems registering for a testing location. Results must be on file at the time of residence hall check-in (for residential students), or the first day of classes (for commuter students).

Due to a delayed delivery of home testing kits, out-of-state students are encouraged to consider all testing options, including but not limited to testing at a drive-thru location, clinic, or scheduling a test with GuideSafe at one of the in-state (AL) testing sites. Results from in-state testing are transmitted to the University within 24-hours of testing. You will need to provide a copy of your results if testing at a drive-thru location or clinic.

Please confirm your negative COVID-19 test results before arriving to campus as access will be restricted without it.
